To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. *95,072* for *160* acres, in favor of *John Everingham, and Charles Everingham, minor children of Samuel Everingham deceased Private Captain St. John's Company New York Militia War 1812*

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon *the north half of the north east quarter of Section twenty one, and the north half of the north west quarter of Section twenty two, in Township twenty five, of Range three East, in the district of Lands subject to sale at Dakota City Nebraska containing one hundred and sixty acres*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL *the said warrant having been assigned by the said John Everingham and Charles Everingham to Asel Wilcox, and by Asel Wilcox, ^{David Collins Senior and} Samuel J. Wells Executors of the ^{last will and testament} of the said Asel Wilcox deceased to Damon E. Chey and by him to Halsey H. Moses in whose favor said tract has been located*

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Halsey H. Moses as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Halsey H. Moses as assignee as aforesaid and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
